1. Purpose

To sunset this Policy #009 (Authorization to Apply for, Accept and Use, and Monitoring Requirements for, Novel Coronavirus Pandemic (COVID-19) Public Health Emergency Funds) which went into effect on May 22, 2020.

During the Novel Coronavirus Pandemic (COVID-19) Public Health Emergency funding was made available by the U.S. Treasury through the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act or the "CARES Act." This funding provided a direct disbursement to counties meeting certain population thresholds. The law provided a deadline of December 30, 2020 for expenditure of all received funds. This deadline was extended to December 31, 2021 by section 1001 of Division N of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021, Pub. L. No 116-260 (Dec. 27, 2020).

County allocations of these funds were substantially completed by December 30, 2020. Further, the Federal, State, and Local proclamations of emergency have all terminated as of May 11, 2023, allowing this policy to end.
